

# MOSLEM CHANGES MIND, WILL FIGHT FOR U. S.

NEW YORK, Feb. 7 (U.P.)—A 22-year-old Brooklyn Moslem was arrested by the FBI today on charges of failing to report for induction into the Army, then released after he changed his mind.

The youth, York Cunningham, who wears a fez and carries a prayer rug, had insisted that he be exempted on grounds that being a soldier would interfere with his study of religion.

After a hurried consultation with his spiritual instructor, Allahu Akbar Shaik Daoud Ahmed Faisal, leader of the Islamic Mission of America, Cunningham changed his mind and agreed to report for induction tomorrow morning.

The Moslem leader said he told the youth that Moslems fight for their country and cleared up his fears of conflict with his religion.
