Harvest And Interfaith Service At St. Thomas

St. Thomas Liberal Catholic church, 147 W. 144th st., will hold its annual Harvest and Interfaith service on Sunday, Nov. 4, at 4 p. m.

A program featuring the Fatherhood of God and the Brotherhood of Man will be demonstrated by Buddhist monks, Meham-

medan priests, Jewish rabbis and other religious leaders.

The service will open with the call to prayer by the Rev. Shai-ki Daoud Ahmed Faisal, head of the Islamic Mission of America.
